





From 2002 on: digital information available free of charge but licenses applied for commercial use. More than 8 millions downloads accumulated.



From 2015 on: Delivering geoinformation under CC BY license: ICGC's data can be used with commercial purposes just quoting the ICGC as its author.








At the early stages took up to 4 weeks to deliver aerial photography.




New role of the staff in touch with the public
