
Estonia 2010-2012



A new portal for the Estonian national bibliography database ERB is now also available in English. For historical reasons no one map collection in Estonia can hold every map published in Estonia, and thus the National Library has taken on the task to gather information from different collections into this common database.

The National Archives of Estonia continues digitisation of old manuscript plans and historical maps. A new map information system was made ready to use in 2011. For the time being, 20 000 items have been digitised.





Estonian Land Board has added many digitised topographic maps into the geo-portal map application 'Historical maps' from the years 1945-1992, also cadastral maps from 1930-1944 and 1978-1989, and orthophotos starting in 1993. The Land Board has also developed public search system of addresses and place names register.

Estonian Geoinformatics Society was founded in 2010.
